O R D E R

THIS MATTER is before the Court on the July 14, 2000 Report and Recommendation of Magistrate Judge Welton Curtis Sewell addressing Plaintiff's Motion for Default Judgment in this in rem action against several Defendant Internet domain names registered by Alexander Maximov.

Federal Rule of Civil Procedure 72(b) requires a district judge to whom such a case is assigned to "make a de novo determination upon the record, or after additional evidence, of any portion of the magistrate judge's disposition to which specific written objection has been made in accordance with this rule." FED. R. CIV. P. 72(b).


