ORDER

Case No. 2:99-CV-808C

This matter is before the court on plaintiff's motion for a temporary restraining order and preliminary injunction. The court conducted a hearing on the motion for a temporary restraining order on October 18, 1999, at which plaintiff was represented by Todd E. Zenger and Berne S. Broadbent, defendants were represented by Brian Barnard. For the reasons set forth at the close of the hearing, the court GRANTS plaintiff's motion for a temporary restraining order, in part, as follows:

1. Defendants shall remove and keep off defendant's website the material alleged to infringe plaintiff's copyright.
2. Defendants shall remove the topical index listing for the material alleged to infringe plaintiff's copyright.
3. Defendants shall not reproduce or distribute verbatim, in a tangible medium,

material alleged to infringe plaintiff's copyright.

The court DENIES without prejudice all other relief sought by plaintiffs.

Pursuant to stipulation, this order will remain in effect until plaintiff's motion for preliminary injunction is resolved.

Defendants' opposition to plaintiff's motion for preliminary injunction is due October 28, 1999. Plaintiff's reply is due November 5, 1999. A hearing on plaintiff's motion for preliminary injunction is set for November 10, 1999. If counsel intends to rely on witness testimony, an affidavit of the direct testimony shall be attached to the pleadings. Opposing counsel may depose witnesses who have filed affidavits. Counsel shall have witnesses who filed an affidavit available at the hearing, if opposing counsel notifies counsel they intend to cross examine the witness at the hearing.
